To Level II Coaches:

Thank you for your commitment and dedication in helping The First Tee of Fort Worth impact the youths in our communities. Congratulations on your decision and desire to continue to stay active as a Level II Coach. To maintain your status as a Level I Coach you are required to take an annual Level I Coach assessment designed to refresh and enhance your understanding of The First Tee Life Skills Experience.

Your annual Level II Coach Assessment to stay active is accessed through your LITMOS coach account. When you login to your LITMOS coach account, it gives you your due date in RED to complete your annual Level II Coach Assessment. Level II Coaches will be sent 90-day, 60-day, and 30-day reminders in your LITMOS coach account until you complete the assessment. You have 365 Days from the time you became a Level II Coach, or 365 days from when you completed your annual Level II Coach assessment last year.

Please contact the Managing Coaches-In-Training Coordinator when you have successfully completed your annual Level II Assessment. This will ensure the coordinator has the most current and up-to-date records and coaches are not listed as inactive.
