To Level I Coaches Wanting to Attend a Level II Coach Training Session:

Pre-Requisites for Attending a Level II Coach Training:

Be in good standing with the chapter and receive approval to attend a Level II coach training session by the Executive Director.

- Read the documents and material provided in the Level II Coach-In-Training Informational Folder.
- After reading the documents:
 - o Sign the Level II Coach-In-Training Agreement form acknowledging your understanding of the responsibilities, requirements and reimbursement policies of attending a Level II Coach Training session.
 - o Contact the chapter's Managing Coaches-In-Training Coordinator you have followed the above procedures and you wish to request consideration to attend a national Level II Coach Training session.
 - o The Managing Coaches-In-Training Coordinator will submit your name to the Executive Director for consideration to attend a Level II Coach Training session.

Upon approval by the Executive Director:

- The Managing Coaches-In-Training Coordinator will notify Level I Coach applicants of the Executive Director's approval to attend a Level II Coach Training session.
- The Managing Coaches-In-Training Coordinator will go over the current year Level II Training schedule to verify you can attend the days of the desired training dates.
- As directed by the Executive Director, the Managing Coaches-In-Training Coordinator will register approved Level I Coaches for the designated Level II Coach Training session and pay the training fee.
