Continuing Education Units (CEUs)
Letter

In 2018, The First Tee transitioned to “Salesforce,” a Customer Relationship Management (CRM) platform that will help the home office and chapters be more effective and streamlined. The First Tee also created a new online eLearning platform called LITMOS. Current active coaches are required to set up individual LITMOS coach accounts. If you have not received your individual LITMOS coach account informational e-mail from The First Tee Coach Training staff, please notify the Managing Coaches-In-Training Coordinator and request to have this e-mail sent to you.

The First Tee of Fort Worth requires all lead coaches to complete the eLearning Child Protection/Risk Management course. Access to the Child Protection course is through your LITMOS coach account. The Child Protection course is one of the checklists in Part II of the CEU Guidelines. The Child Protection course can only be taken one time and cannot be retaken every 3-years for CEU purposes.

Coaches at all levels are now able to see their own current coaching training status, post coach training requirements and deadlines, and any eLearning courses they may have started or completed through their individual LITMOS coach account. The First Tee Coaches will be able to keep track of their own current three-year cycle Parts I and II checklist CEU requirements.

CEU requirements will now be completed as a checklist (Parts I and II), instead of earning a minimum required number of CEUs. The First Tee no longer has the requirement to earn CEUs in certain categories. In fact, CEU categories no longer exist. Please read the “**New Guidelines to Continuing Education Units (CEUs) for recognized The First Tee Coaches**” provided in your 2018 statement folder.

The First Tee Coaches will upload completed Part I and II checklist items through LITMOS. Keeping up with checklist items and planning ahead will be key to completing required CEUs by the end of your three-year cycle. Waiting till the last minute to accrue CEUs was not the way the program was designed.
