

Coach Training Funding and Reimbursement Policy Volunteer Coaches

The First Tee has a Coach Training program to educate and train coaches about The First Tee Coach Philosophy and how to deliver The First Tee Life Skills Curriculum. To be Lead Coaches and conduct The First Tee Life Skills curriculum, The First Tee requires all coaches to be trained to a certain Coach Training level (Level I Coach, Level II Coach, or The First Tee Coach), depending on the Life Skills classes they teach (PLAYer, Par, Birdie, Eagle, or ACE).

The First Tee of Fort Worth will fund Volunteer Coaches to attend The First Tee Level I, II, and III coach trainings in the following manner as approved by the Executive Director.

- 1. The First Tee of Fort Worth will pay the coach training fees to attend in-person Level I, II and III coach trainings.
- 2. The First Tee of Fort Worth does not provide reimbursement for coach training expenses for Volunteer Coaches.

NOTE: The First Tee of Fort Worth will make every effort to send Volunteer Coaches to the closest Level coach training possible to lower travel and hotel expenses.
