The First Tee Coach Program relies on developing a philosophy that supports and enhances The First Tee Life Skills Experience.

**Status: Assistant Coach.**

Completed the Assistant Coach Training (ACT) eLearning online course.

**Status: Level I CIT (Coach-in-Training)**

Be an active Assistant Coach

Attended Level I coach training, but has not completed and submitted post-Level I CIT assessment requirements.

**Status: Level I Coach**

Attended Level I coach training.

Completed/submitted/approved post-Level I CIT assessment requirements.

**Status: Level II CIT (Coach-in-Training)**

Be an active Level I Coach.

Attended Level II coach training, but has not completed and submitted post-Level II CIT assessment requirements.

**Status: Level II Coach**

Attended Level II coach training.

Completed/submitted/approved post-Level II CIT assessment requirements.

**Status: Level III CIT (Coach-in-Training)**

Be an active Level II Coach.

Attended Level III coach training, but has not completed and submitted post-Level III CIT assessment requirements.

**Status: The First Tee Coach (Recognized Coach)**

Attended Level III coach training.

Completed/submitted/approved post-Level III CIT assessment requirements.

**Status: The First Tee Master Coach**

Be an active The First Tee Coach.

Met specific time requirements and other pre-requisites.

Applied and was accepted for entry into The First Tee Master Coach program.

Completed/Submitted/Approved Master Coach project.

All coaches are encouraged to progress through The First Tee Coach Training program to become a The First Tee Coach, but are no longer required to. Individual coaches now have the option to stay active as an Assistant Coach, a Level I Coach, or a Level II Coach by completing annual re-assessments. The First Tee Coaches maintain their active coach status by earning required Continuing Educational Units (CEUs) during designated three year cycles.
